

Blessing Bags

Last month, the Deacons came up with the idea of Blessing Bags in order to be able to respond quickly to requests for assistance from families in need.

Each bag contains approximately \$25 worth of grocery items, specifically:

- Box of Cereal
- Chicken Broth
- Jar (or can) Pasta Sauce
- Spaghetti noodles
- Mac and Cheese
- Jar of unsweetened Applesauce
- Can of fruit packed in fruit juice
- Can of beans
- Jar of peanut butter
- Two cans of tuna or chicken
- Can of green beans
- Can of corn
- Bag of rice
- Two 18 oz cans of soup (like chunky chicken noodle)
- Bar soap
- Toothpaste

We want to thank you for the ways you've shown your support for our community and people in need!

As we continue this program to support those in need at either of our campus communities (St Peters and Ferguson) we want to remind you of the ways you can help:

- Put together complete bags (or boxes) for families in need
- Contribute \$25 to allow us to purchase the items for a bag


